WINTER WEATHER

Winter in Gaston County is crisp, festive, and full of charm. Daytime temperatures typically range from the mid-50s to low $60s^{\circ}F$ ($12-16^{\circ}C$), while evenings can dip into the 30s and $40s^{\circ}F$ ($0-5^{\circ}C$), so warm layers are essential. Mornings are often chilly and sometimes misty, making a cozy jacket or sweater a must. December can bring occasional rain, so a light waterproof layer or umbrella is helpful. While the vibrant fall foliage has faded, the county lights up with holiday decorations, seasonal events, and scenic winter landscapes perfect for exploring.




